## To Whom It May Concern,

I am writing to inform you that the Minister for Transport, Tourism and Sport Paschal Donohoe, TD has signed the order for the merger of the National Roads Authority (the Authority) with the Railway Procurement Agency (RPA) to establish a single new entity called Transport Infrastructure Ireland (TII).

TII brings together two organisations to provide high quality transport infrastructure and services, delivering a better quality of life and supporting economic growth.

The Roads Act 2015 sets out the legal structure for the transfer of the RPA's functions, staff and contractual agreements with all rights and liabilities statutorily to the Authority. The Authority will use the name Transport Infrastructure Ireland (TII) for operational purposes from the establishment date of the 1<sup>st</sup> of August 2015. All existing contractual relationships with the National Roads Authority (the Authority) remain unaffected.

TII will provide opportunities to:

- Ensure an integrated approach to the future development of the national roads network and the development of light rail;
- Combine the expertise and proven record of the organisations which have delivered the Luas and the National Motorway Network thereby offering the potential for innovation and optimised delivery in the context of national roads, light rail and other infrastructure initiatives and programmes; and
- Ensure value for money by virtue of improved scale and the combining of complementary NRA and RPA commercial, financial and technical competencies.

TII will be headquartered in Parkgate Business Centre, Parkgate Street, Dublin 8 and hardcopy correspondence should be sent to that address. All invoices from the 1<sup>st</sup> of August 2015 should now be addressed to TII. Any queries in relation to invoicing and payment procedures should be emailed to [accountspayable@tii.ie](mailto:accountspayable@tii.ie).

Additionally, all current email addresses for both the NRA and RPA will automatically be directed to the new TII email addresses @tii.ie. Táim ag scríobh chugat lena chur in iúl duit gur shínigh an tAire Iompair, Turasóireachta agus Spóirt, Paschal Donohoe, T.D., an t-ordú chun an tÚdarás um Bóithre Náisiúnta (an tÚdarás) agus an Ghníomhaireacht um Fháil Iarnród (RPA) a chomhcheangal chun aonán singil nua a bhunú ar a dtugtar Bonneagar Iompair Éireann (TII).

Tugann TII dhá eagraíocht le chéile chun bonneagar agus seirbhísí iompair ardhchaighdeáin a sholáthar, a sholáthraíonn cáilíocht beatha níos fearr agus a thacaíonn le borradh geilleagrach.

Leagtar amach in Acht na mBóithre, 2015 an struchtúr dlíthiúil chun feidhmeanna, foireann agus comhaontuithe conarthacha an RPA mar aon le gach ceart agus dlíteanas a aistriú go reachtúil chuig an Údarás. Úsáidfídh an tÚdarás an t-ainm 'Bonneagar Iompair Éireann (TII) ar mhaithe le cuspóirí oibríochtúla ón dáta bunaithe an 1 Lúnasa 2015 ar aghaidh. Ní dhéantar difear d'aon chaidreamh conarthach reatha leis an Údarás um Bóithre Náisiúnta (an tÚdarás).

Soláthróidh TII deiseanna chun an méid a leanas a dhéanamh:

- Cur chuige comhtháite a chinntiú i leith fhorbairt an ghréasáin náisiúnta bhóithre amach anseo agus iarnród éadroim a fhorbairt;
- Saineolas agus cuntas teiste na n-eagraíochtaí a chomhcheangal, a sholáthair an Luas agus an Gréasán Náisiúnta Mótarbhealaigh, agus an cumas a chur ar fáil, dá bharr, chun nuálaíocht agus soláthar barrfheabhsaithe a bhaint amach i gcomhthéacs bóithre náisiúnta, iarnród éadrom agus tionscnaimh agus cláir bhonneagair eile; agus
- Luach ar airgead a chinntiú de bhrí scála feabhsaithe agus inniúlachtaí tráchtála, airgeadais agus teicniúla comhlíontacha an NRA agus an RPA a chomhcheangal.

Beidh ceanncheathrú TII lonnaithe i Lárionad Gnó Gheata na Páirce, Sráid Gheata na Páirce, Baile Átha Cliath 8 agus ba cheart comhfhreagras cruachóipe a sheoladh chuig an seoladh sin. Ba cheart gach sonrasc ón 1 Lúnasa 2015 ar aghaidh a sheoladh anois chuig TII. Ba cheart aon cheisteanna maidir le sonrascú agus nósanna imeachta íocaíochta a chur ar ríomhphost chuig [accountspayable@tii.ie](mailto:accountspayable@tii.ie).

Anuas air sin, seolfar gach seoladh reatha ríomhphoist don NRA agus don RPA araon go huathoibríoch chuig seoltaí nua ríomhphoist TII @tii.ie. Cé go mbeidh na seoltaí ríomhphoist reatha oibríochtúil ar feadh roinnt míonna, iarrtar ort d'fhaisnéis teagmhála ríomhphoist a nuashonrú dá réir sin i ndiaidh an 1 Lúnasa 2015.
