Delegation of Authority

The Highways Agency is an executive agency of the Department for Transport and responsible on behalf of the Secretary of State for Transport for operating, maintaining and improving England's motorways and trunk roads. The highway and traffic authority functions and obligations that are placed on and give powers to the Secretary of State for Transport are exercised on their behalf by the Highways Agency. This includes the A282 Trunk Road (Dartford – Thurrock Crossing Charging Scheme) Order 2013.

The Highways Agency hereby confirms that we have delegated our function of tracing, issuing and collecting of road user charging related notices/charges/fees issued to vehicles registered outside the Highways Agency's jurisdiction to Sanef Operations who has sub-contracted to Euro Parking Collection plc, of Shepperton House, 83-93 Shepperton Road, London N1 3DF, United Kingdom ("EPC").

EPC acts on our behalf and the ultimate responsibility lies with the Highways Agency. EPC has the authority, in any relevant jurisdiction and on behalf of the Highways Agency, to appoint a lawyer or other professionally qualified person to assist EPC in the performance of the delegation described above.

This Delegation of Authority is valid until further notice. The Highways Agency may terminate it by giving not less than 28 days written notice to Sanef Operations or EPC.
